Note:

- Besides the Periodic Assessment , the teachers may conduct class tests (oral or written) with prior intimation.
- Each Term will be of 100 marks. Periodic Assessment – 20 marks which includes Unit Test 5 marks, S.E.A. 5 marks, Multiple Assessments 5 marks and notebook submission 5 marks and 80 marks for Terminal Exam.
- Two Unit Tests will be conducted in each term.
- In case the scheduled date of any Assessment or Activity happens to be a holiday, the Assessment will be conducted on the next working day.
- No Re-test will be conducted for any student who misses a Unit Test whatever the reasons may be. However if a student misses any Unit Test on medical grounds , then he/she will be marked on the basis of the other Tests.
- All notebooks / files /scrapbooks or project work in each subject should be submitted by the dates given by the concerned teachers, failing which no marks will be awarded.
- In case a student misses any class, it is the parents' responsibility to get the work completed. Such students will not be allowed to attend school till their work is complete/ up to date in all respects.
- The syllabus for the Unit Test will be given by the respective teacher well in time before the test.
