- 5. All notebooks / files /scrapbooks or project work in each subject should be submitted by the dates given by the concerned teachers, failing which no marks will be awarded.
- 6. In case a student misses any class, it is the parents' responsibility to get the work completed. Such students will not be allowed to attend school till their work is complete/ up to date in all respects.
- 7. The syllabus for the Unit Test will be given by the respective teacher well in time before the test.
