Note:

1. Besides the Periodic Assessment , the teachers may conduct class tests (oral or written) with prior intimation.
2. Each Term will be of 100 marks. Periodic Assessment – 20 marks which includes Unit Test 5 marks, S.E.A. 5 marks, Multiple Assessments 5 marks and notebook submission 5 marks and 80 marks for Terminal Exam.
3. Two Unit Tests will be conducted in each term.
4. In case the scheduled date of any Assessment or Activity happens to be a holiday, the Assessment will be conducted on the next working day.
5. No Re-test will be conducted for any student who misses a Unit Test whatever the reasons may be. However if a student misses any Unit Test on medical grounds , then he/she will be marked on the basis of the other Tests.
6. All notebooks / files /scrapbooks or project work in each subject should be submitted by the dates given by the concerned teachers, failing which no marks will be awarded.
7. In case a student misses any class, it is the parents' responsibility to get the work completed. Such students will not be allowed to attend school till their work is complete/ up to date in all respects.
8. The syllabus for the Unit Test will be given by the respective teacher well in time before the test.
