- Help in the household activities.


Practice following conversational questions :

Fill the clouds by dabbing the black colour using cottonballs. Then make stars with white colour by using earbuds.


Let's make a beautiful night cloud.





Pick up your colourful crayons and colour the picture below.







FATHERS LIKE MOTHERS, are pillars in the development of a child's emotional well being.


Children look to their fathers to lay down the rules and enforce them. They also look to their fathers to provide a feeling of security, both physical and emotional.

- 2. Lemonade.



Making a cardboard guitar can be a fun DIY project! Here's a basic guide: Materials you'll need:

- 1. Cardboard
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Pencil
- 4. Glue
- 5. Rubber bands (for strings)
- 6. Paints or markers (for decoration, optional)

Steps:

- 1. Cut out the shape of a guitar body from the cardboard.
- 2. Cut a long, thin strip of cardboard for the neck.
- 3. Attach the neck to the body using glue, making sure it's centered.
- 4. Cut out holes for the tuning pegs at the top of the neck.
- 5. Attach cardboard pieces for the headstock.
- 6. Stretch rubber bands across the body.
- Decorate your guitar with paints or markers if desired. Voila! You've made a cardboard guitar. Adjustments can be made based on the size and style you prefer.
