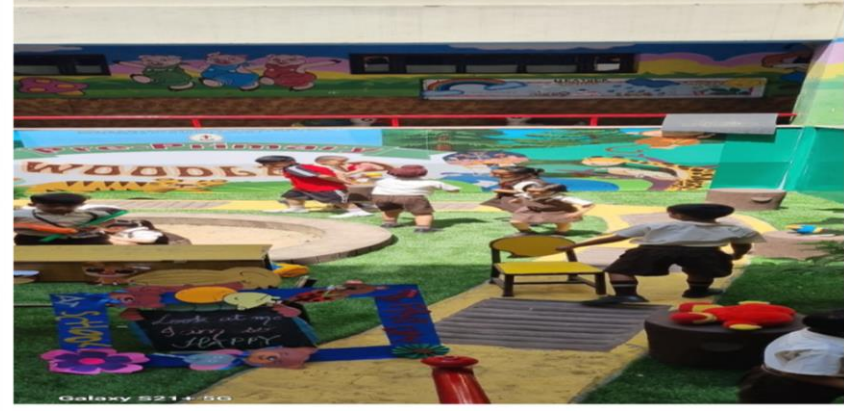
The new session began with special assemblies, featuring a delightful play on golden words, encouraging students to embrace the magic of kind and respectful language.







The excitement continued as students enjoyed a fun-filled day, engaging in various games and activities, and capturing joyful moments with their friends.







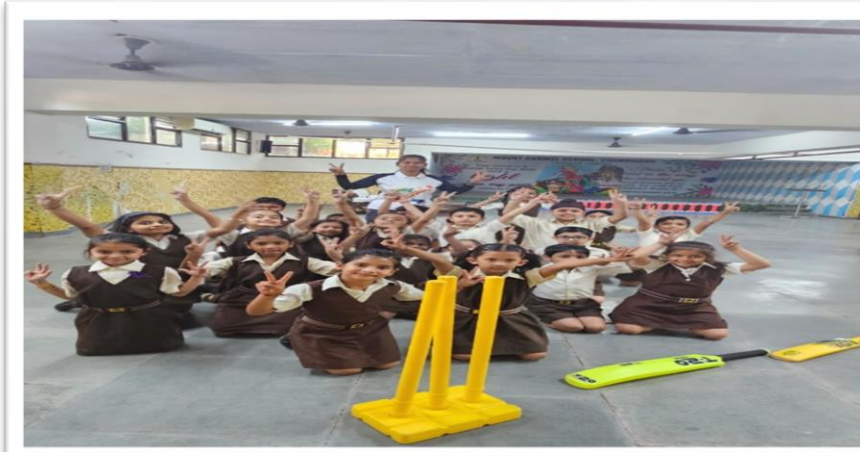

Our esteemed Principal also commended and inspired the students for their thoughtful efforts.



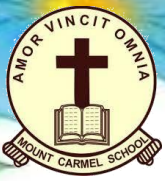
