3. The Username & Password is being shared by the Class In-charges with the students individually.

4. Login instructions for students:

The following guide outlines the steps required to make sure the IBT assessment is administered appropriately. It is critical to follow these guidelines strictly in order to ensure the integrity of the test and to reliably measure a student's achievement.

- a) You need a computer device (computer, laptop, tablet, etc.) and an internet connection to complete the test.
- b) Once the student is seated at the computer or before any other device, load the URL provided at Point Number 2 to get to the online assessment login page.
- c) The student should enter his/her username and password, and click log in. Please note that all username and password are case sensitive.
- d) If you are appearing for the test on a phone or tablet, please use landscape mode to have a full view of the question paper.
- e) The student will see a screen listing the current assessment assigned to him/her. Once this test is completed, next test will appear as per the decided schedule.
- f) If the test has begun and been interrupted (e.g., due to loss of electricity/ internet service), the student may resume it from where it was last stopped by logging in again, as long as the student has not pressed the FINISH button at the end of the test.
- g) **You should click on the FINISH button only when the test has been completed.**
- h) The test has 40-45 questions.
- i) You are allowed 60 minutes to complete the test.
- j) Read each question carefully.
- k) Click on the circle next to your answer.
- l) To change your answer, click on a different circle.
- m) Click NEXT to move to the next question.
- n) You can skip questions and return to them later.
- o) Click on a question number (at the top of the screen) if you want to go to a specific question.
- p) The question number becomes shaded when it has been completed.
- q) You are permitted to use a pen/pencil and paper to make notes during the test.
- r) You are not permitted to use any other materials.
- s) Test will be considered completed only after student clicks finish button.
