Things You See in Nature: Trees, flowers, birds, sky, sun, moon, animals, clouds, etc. Describe their colours, shapes and beauty.

Sounds You Hear: Chirping of birds, flowing water, rustling leaves, thunder, rain or wind. Write how these sounds make you feel.

Feelings and Experience: Fresh air, cool breeze, warm sunlight, soft grass. Explain how being in nature makes you feel peaceful and happy.

End your scrapbook with a short paragraph titled "My Promise to Nature", writing how you will protect and care for the Environment.

Note:
